### **DEPARTMENT FUNCTION**

The Chemotherapy Ward at Lymington Hospital provides day care for patients receiving chemotherapy. Força – Strength Against Cancer is a local charity that funds nutritious, frozen meals for people receiving chemotherapy at Lymington hospital. The meals are prepared and cooked by the catering team at Oakhaven Hospice

### AIM OF ROLE

The Chemo Support volunteer provides non-clinical support to the Chemo Ward by:

- taking orders for meals and fulfilling the orders using the stock of meals which are kept in the dedicated freezer at Lymington Hospital,
- assisting with practical tasks such as making drinks,
- engaging with the patients whilst they are undergoing their treatment.

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

This role would suit a friendly and compassionate person who is empathetic, caring and practical.

This role involves various tasks, including:-

- Serving refreshments
- Engaging with patients throughout the day
- Taking orders for frozen meals for patients to take home
- Keeping food and drinks area clean and tidy
- Liaise with nursing staff regarding any restrictions for patients
- Liaise with Oakhaven kitchen staff to manage stock levels at the hospital Provide information to patients about other services and support offered by Força – Strength Against Cancer
